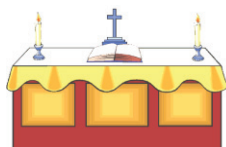

COUNTDOWN FOR LENT

Lent is approaching and will begin on Ash Wednesday, February 22nd.

FAST AND ABSTINENCE DURING LENT

People frequently ask about the discipline of penance at this time of the year. It is important to remember that all Christ's faithful are invited by divine law to do penance, but on certain days the Church prescribes that to be done. Abstinence and Fasting are to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. **Abstinence** is to be observed on all Fridays throughout the Lenten season. The law of abstinence forbids meat, but, Catholics may substitute this practice with special acts of charity or piety. The law of **fasting** prescribes that only one meal is taken in a day; but it does not forbid taking some nourishment in the morning and evening. The obligation to fast binds those between 18 and 59 years of age. The law of abstinence pertains to everyone over 14. Individual cases, for just reason (e.g., the sick), may receive dispensation from the obligation. **Eucharistic Fasting**: No eating 1 hour prior to receiving communion.

WORLD DAY OF THE SICK – February 11th

“The ministry of Jesus to the sick is central to the life of the Church. February 11th (Memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes) highlights the healing ministry of the Church. It reminds us that service to the sick and suffering cannot be neglected. It recognizes the great efforts of doctors, nurses, health care institutions and pastoral care givers to restore health to those afflicted with illness and disease”.

A QUARESMA SE APROXIMA

A Quaresma se aproxima e começará na Quarta-feira de Cinzas, 22 de Fevereiro.

JEJUM E ABSTINÊNCIA NA QUARESMA

As pessoas frequentemente perguntam sobre a disciplina da penitência nesta época do ano. É importante lembrar que todos os fiéis de Cristo são convidados pela lei divina a fazer penitência, mas em certos dias a Igreja prescreve que isso seja feito. A abstinência e o jejum devem ser observados na Quarta-feira de Cinzas e na Sexta-feira Santa. A abstinência deve ser observada em todas as sextas-feiras durante a Quaresma. A lei da abstinência proíbe a carne, mas os católicos podem substituir esta prática por atos especiais de caridade ou piedade. A lei do jejum prescreve que apenas uma refeição seja feita por dia; mas não proíbe tomar algum alimento pela manhã e à noite. A obrigação de jejuar obriga os maiores de 18 a 59 anos. A lei de abstinência se aplica a todos os maiores de 14 anos. Casos individuais, por justa causa (por exemplo, doentes), podem ser dispensados da obrigação. Jejum Eucarístico: Não comer 1 hora antes de receber a comunhão.

AYUNO Y ABSTINENCIA DURANTE LA CUARESMA

La gente pregunta con frecuencia sobre la disciplina de la penitencia en esta época del año. Es importante recordar que todos los fieles de Cristo están invitados por ley divina a hacer penitencia, pero en ciertos días la Iglesia prescribe que se haga. La abstinencia y el ayuno se observarán el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo. La abstinencia se debe observar todos los viernes durante la temporada de Cuaresma. La ley de abstinencia prohíbe la carne, pero los católicos pueden sustituir esta práctica con actos especiales de caridad o piedad. La ley del ayuno prescribe que se tome una sola comida al día; pero no prohíbe tomar algún alimento por la mañana y por la noche. La obligación de ayunar vincula a los mayores de 18 a 59 años. La ley de abstinencia se aplica a todos los mayores de 14 años. Los casos individuales, por justa razón (por ejemplo, los enfermos), pueden recibir dispensa de la obligación. Ayuno Eucarístico: No comer 1 hora antes de recibir la comunión.
