

SISTERS POOR OF JESUS CHRIST

Jesus all, all of Jesus. This is the phrase that covers and summarizes the entire Charism of the Sisters Poor of Jesus Christ. There is in us a deep will and even a daring desire, to want Jesus entirely and to be totally His. The Gospel lived "sine glossa" offers us the sure way by which we can embody all His life in our own lives.

We are attracted by Jesus who, stripping himself totally of His divine condition, became a poor, humble servant: an unreserved gift and sacrifice for all mankind (2 Phil 1-14).
